Brent Theobald, a USMC Combat Veteran, will share his story of finding healing and purpose after serving in Afghanistan, Iraq, and the Horn of Africa. As a member of the elite Marine Force Reconnaissance Company, Brent was among the first American boots on the ground in November 2001 in search of Osama Bin Laden.

After his service, Brent served as Director of Veterans Affairs at Vanguard University. He currently is the Director of Strategic Operations with Far Reaching Ministries, which builds safe havens for thousands of children in Northern Uganda fleeing the brutal reign of terror inflicted by the Lords Resistance Army and ISIS. Brent is married to Caitlin and father of Emmaline.
